The RailLight ([www.shockles.com](http://www.shockles.com)) is a stainless steel, solar-powered LED light that quickly and securely clamps onto any railing from 3/4" to 1 1/4" diameter with a tough nylon clamp that adjusts the light to any height or angle.

Also included is the custom Transom Clamp which adjusts up to 2", making it perfect for attaching to tenders, dinghies, rowboats, canoes—any small boat that needs a safety light. The transom clamp can also be used on cockpit combing, toerails, stanchions—anywhere you want a light for safety, work or visibility.

The RailLight attaches in seconds; no wires, no batteries, no costly installation—just instant light wherever you want it. The sealed epoxy and coated stainless housing will shed water while the dual LEDs are rated for over 10,000 hours. The RailLight provides enough light to dine or even read by.

There's a built-in sensor that automatically turns the light off during daylight and also a protected switch so you can turn off the light at night if you prefer darkness.

The twin, super-bright white LEDs are housed in a double Fresnel lens system so that the light can be seen over 1/4 mile away. On your deck, the RailLight will shed a wonderful glow for up to 8 hours with a full charge of sunlight; since a RailLight is mounted outside it is always charging, no matter if there's bright sunshine or not. There's a built-in circuit to protect the replaceable Ni-Cad batteries from overcharging.

Mount a RailLight on your boarding steps or ladder, on your dock locker or utility box, on your bimini or awning, near your BBQ or swim platform, on dock posts, walkways and picnic tables, or take them to shore for nights on the beach.

The RailLight also makes a perfect emergency light if all your boat power goes out. Use it as an emergency anchor light or signal beacon.

This very cool addition to your cockpit will keep your boat safer as well as add a wonderful touch of nightlight ambience to any boat. And if for any reason you drop a RailLight in the water.... it floats!

For \$27.95 you can have a secure outdoor light virtually anywhere on your boat without having to drill holes, run wires or worry about running down your batteries. Have a sunny night!
